WHILE THERE ARE HUMOREDS of highly acclaimed regetarian and all-natural restaurants across the country, there are still remarkably few that have been designated by the federal Department of Agriculture as certified organic. The first fully certified organic restaurant in the United States was Restaurant Nora (www.noras.com) on Florida Avenue, NW, in Washington, D.C. To obtain certification, owner-chef and cookbook author Nona Poultion had to demonstrate to a certified organic inspector that organic farmers and growers supplied her with at least 95 percent of the ingredients that were consumed by her clientele. Restaurant Nora received its certification in April 1999.

Ms. Position said of her decision to go organic, "Sleath is the most important thing in bits." When she shared the process of certification, she had to locate enough organiculty certified farmers within the District of Columbia/Vegetia area to regularly supply her with organic produce, dairy and means. "It was an education process in the early days with the farmers," she said. "There were no guidelines, no certification agency until the U.S. Department of Agriculture instituted their standards."

Another certified organic restaurant of perticular note is Utiliah Brevaling Company & Rest -aurant Immes utiliah threving Company & Rest -aurant Immes utiliah trevingos comit, Castiernia's first bully certified organic restaurant and the realion's first scriffed organic brewpub. To achieve this status, owners Allien and Elis Coopervider spent thur months in 2001 filling out 150 regulatory forms. They even had its prove that their cleaning products were environmentally triendly. "Wir in not just doing food, beer and wine," said Mr. Coopervider. "The whole operation supports the concept of sustain-side organic twins."
